St. Basil Monastery

It has come to the attention of His Grace, Bishop Nicholas, that a fund-raising letter from St. Basil Monastery, Methuen, Mass., may have been mailed to clergy and faithful around the Eparchy. While Sayidna has no problem with the Salvatorians raising funds for their own needs, he does wish to clarify the following:

1. In 1968, the seminarians who were studying for the then-Exarchate at St. Basil Seminary were sent to St. John Seminary of the Archdiocese of Boston because St. Basil Seminary could not staff the theological program.
2. St. Basil Seminary did not reopen with the arrival of Archbishop Tawil in 1970; St. Gregory Seminary, rather, was soon established for the formation of eparchial seminarians. Thus, since 1968, no priest for the Eparchy of Newton has been educated or formed at St. Basil.
3. All eparchial seminarians currently study at the Sts. Cyril and Methodios Byzantine Seminary in Pittsburgh.
4. Finally, for several years, the Deacon Formation Program for the Eparchy had been housed at St. Basil's, but this became untenable due to repeated scheduling conflicts with the Cursillo programs run by the Salvatorians. And so, since 2005, the Deacon Formation Program has been held at Anna Maria College in Paxton, Mass.
