Return of Daily Morning Prayer

After a successful trial week, morning prayer has returned to every Monday through Friday at the slightly later time of 7:30am. Prayer is always the best way to start the day and it is even better with the renovated ceiling! The theme of the 2018 parish calendar focuses on the prayer life of the church; the month of April talks about the daytime hours:

Coffee breaks, snack breaks, cigarette breaks – the workplace has a number of opportunities for people to renew themselves during the day. Our Tradition encourages people to mark the passage of the day in a similar way: with the “prayer breaks” we call the Hours. These are brief services [about 15-20 minutes] which are generally designed to be read by one or two people during the course of the day. [...] Each Hour is basically identical from day to day so that people could recite them without having a book in hand.
